


Release notes - PetHealthData - VBooklet

From 14 March 2024, a new function for pet owners will be available on the PHBooklet platform: the vaccination record (abbreviated to "VBooklet"). This function allows pet owners to digitally record their pet's vaccinations in a structured way.

In this first version of the VBooklet, the pet's physical passport is scanned by the owner and uploaded into the VBooklet. Vaccines that have already been administered must be entered by the owner in a structured way. At this stage, the vaccines entered cannot be validated. Veterinary surgeons can consult their patients' VBooklet, but cannot yet enter any data.



This first version of the VBooklet serves as a preparation for a later validated version, which should be available from the end of April 2024. We therefore ask you to continue entering vaccinations in the yellow vaccination booklet/pet passport until this date. In future, the owner will be able to have the downloaded scan and the vaccinations entered in the vaccination booklet/pet passport checked by a central office. The veterinary surgeon will then be able to enter the new vaccinations directly into the vaccination booklet at the vaccination consultation and validate them automatically.
